Transmission Line Project Easton and Mansfield, Massachusetts

Dear Neighbors and Municipal Officials,

As you know, in order to serve Mansfield Municipal Electric Department's (MMED) new substation on Bird Road in Mansfield, National Grid is currently constructing a new overhead transmission line within the existing right-of-way near your home or business in **Easton and Mansfield**.


Beginning the first week in December and continuing through January and into February, a helicopter will be used to install conductors onto the existing structures between Bird Road in Mansfield and National Grid's substation on Depot Street in Easton. The work will be intermittent and will last approximately 1 to 3 days at a time. The work will be conducted during normal working hours, including Saturdays when necessary.

You will notice the helicopter flying overhead and hovering over certain areas. There will be brief, momentary street closures as the helicopter crosses the roadways.

The schedule will be dependent on weather conditions and holidays and may need to be adjusted from time to time.
