

## INVITATION TO BID

The Easton Department of Public Works, Easton, MA (the Owner), requests sealed bids for Roof Replacement at Fire Station No. 3 and Appurtenant Work, Contract DPW 2012-9.

1. Sealed bids for General Contractor Work, endorsed "Roof Replacement at Fire Station No. 3 and Appurtenant Work, Contract DPW 2012-9, Easton, MA" will be received at the Office of the Town Administrator, 136 Elm Street, North Easton, MA 02356, until 10:00 AM, on Wednesday, November 30, 2011, at which time and place bids will be opened publicly and read aloud.
2. Prospective Bidders for Contract DPW 2012-9 shall submit with their bids a copy of a certificate from the Massachusetts Division of Capital Assets Maintenance showing their eligibility to bid on this project, together with an "Update Statement" (Form CQ3). Prospective bidders must be prequalified under the "Roofing" category.
3. The work includes, but is not limited to, replacement of the roof with a new standing seam metal roof, at Fire Station No. 3, 413 Bay Road, Easton, MA. The old asphalt shingles, gutters and downspouts will remain.

5. Bid Security in the form of a certified check or bid bond, payable to the Owner, is required as follows:  
General Bid: Five percent (5%) of the General Bid amount.
6. A pre-bid meeting will be held at 10:00 AM on Wednesday, November 23, 2011, at the Easton Water Division office, 417 Bay Road, Easton, MA. The Water Division office is adjacent to Fire Station No. 3.
7. The successful General Bidder must furnish 100 percent (100%) Performance Bond and 100 percent (100%) Labor and Materials Bond.
8. The successful bidder will be required to complete the work by June 1, 2012.
9. The Town of Easton reserves the right to reject any and all bids should it be in the public interest to do so.

10. MASSACHUSETTS GENERAL LAWS, CHAPTER 149, Sections 44A – 44H, AS AMENDED TO DATE APPLIES. Contract DPW 2012-9 is subject to the minimum wage rates issued by the Commissioner of Labor and Industries, in accordance with Chapter 149, Sections 26 and 27D.
11. Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Engineer, or their respective employees arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation or recommendation of any bid.
