

**MINUTES OF BOARD OF HEALTH MEETING
NOVEMBER 22, 2010 – 6:00 P.M.

In attendance: Chairperson Jennifer Nichols, Members Gil Heino and Dr. Scott Aronson, Agent Mark Taylor and Office Asst. Teressa Wooding.

Variance

2 Armor Ln. (1)

Mr. Taylor informed the Board that a permit is required for this property and design plans must be approved to install a polymil barrier at the foundation. Dr. Aronson motioned to grant the variance to install a polymil barrier at the foundation with design plans approved by Board of Health. Mr. Heino seconded. Unanimous vote.

Action/Discussion Item

Smoking Coalition – Marilyn Edge

Marilyn Edge of Massachusetts Tobacco Control for Bristol County and Police Chief Alan Krajcik was present. After some discussion it was agreed to allow Ms. Edge to conduct the proposed smoking program.

Otis Spunkmeyer

Ray Sploboda of Otis Spunkmeyer and a tenant of the Belmont St. Apartments, Scott Brennan were present. Mr. Taylor informed the Board that Mr. Sploboda has made some adjustments to control the noise and odor from the storage trailers. Mr. Sploboda has installed noise reduction blanket on one trailer and is now code compliant at the building. The Board suggested adding a noise reduction blanket on the second trailer and speaking with the owner of the apartment building and discussing the idea of adding vegetation between the buildings. After some discussion the Board recommended that Mr. Splododa do whatever is necessary to resolve the noise and odor created by the storage trailers. Mr. Taylor will go back to test again when the noise reduction blanket is added to the second trailer.
