



**MINUTES OF BOARD OF HEALTH MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 13, 2010 – 6:00 P.M.

*In attendance: Chairperson Jennifer Nichols, Members Gil Heino and Dr. Scott Aronson, Agent Mark Taylor and Office Asst. Teresa Wooding.*

*Meeting opened: 6:00 p.m.*

*Approval of Minutes*

*July 6, 2010 – Mr. Heino motioned to approve the minutes. Dr. Aronson seconded. Mrs. Nichols abstained.*

*July 19, 2010, July 30, 2010 and August 2, 2010 – Mr. Heino motioned to approve the minutes. Dr. Aronson seconded. Unanimous vote.*

*September 2, 2009 Mr. Heino motioned to approve the minutes. Mrs. Nichols and Dr. Aronson were not Board members at that time so they just acknowledge the recording of the minutes*

*Variance*

*66 Rockland St.(1)*

*Engineer Brad Fitzgerald from Senna Fitzgerald Gilbert was present. Mr. Taylor recommended approval. Dr. Aronson motioned to grant the variance to allow the increase of the maximum cover over the septic tank and the pump chamber from the required 36" to 4.3", to allow the reduction of the setback distance from a pump chamber to the edge of the bordering vegetated wetlands from the required 25' to 19', to allow the reduction of the setback distance from a leaching facility to the edge of the bordering vegetated wetlands from 50' to 19' and to allow the distance of the septic tank and pump chamber inlet and outlet tees to be below the water table, instead of the required 12" above. Mr. Heino seconded. Unanimous vote*

*7 Lynda Rd.(1)*

*Engineer Pat Carrera of PMP Associates was present. Mr. Taylor recommended approval. Mr. Heino motioned to grant the variance to allow a four-foot separation to maximum groundwater. Dr. Aronson seconded. Unanimous vote.*

*201 Elm St.(1)*

*Engineer George Collins of Collins Civil Engineering Group, Inc. was present. Mr. Taylor recommended approval. Dr. Aronson motioned to grant the variance to allow a*

three-foot separation to maximum groundwater. Mr. Heino seconded. Unanimous vote.

#### Discussion-Request for comments on Remote Participation in Public Meeting

After some discussion the Board found that remote participation in a public meeting is not relevant to this office.

#### Trash Survey Update

Mr. Taylor informed the Board that the results of Mrs. Kennedy's survey indicate that the rubbish companies are combining regular trash and recycled trash on their reports. After some discussion it was decided that Mrs. Kennedy will continue to collect the information from the rubbish companies and the Board will wait for her results.

#### Complaint Log Review

After some discussion of the complaint procedures the Board suggested a change to show the time the complaint was received and when it was resolved. Check with the Town Clerk to verify the confidentiality status and is there a length of time the records need to be kept on file.

#### Smoking Regulations

After some discussion the Board suggested that Mr. Taylor talk with Town Counsel and confirm regulations to allow a restaurant to close and have a private smoking party in a public facility.
