

**MINUTES OF BOARD OF HEALTH MEETING
JUNE 7 2010 - 6:00 P.M.

In attendance: Chairperson Jennifer Nichols, Members Gil Heino and Dr. Scott Aronson, Agent Mark Taylor and Office Asst. Teresa Wooding.

Meeting opened: 6:00 p.m.

Variance

7 Olde Farm Rd.

Mr. Heino motioned to table plans until next meeting. The design engineer was not present as required by Board of Health regulations. Dr. Aronson seconded. Unanimous vote.

Old Colony YMCA

Mr. Heino motioned to request guidance from Town Council regarding acceptance of training provided by Ellis Associates, using the Emergency Care and Safety Institute curriculum, in place of the CPR required by the 105 CMR 430.103 Minimum Standards for Recreational Camps of Children, Supervision of Specialized Activities and 105 CMR 435.23 Minimum Standards for Swimming Pools, Lifeguards. Dr. Aronson seconded. Unanimous vote.

Discussion – A Bread Co.

Mr. Taylor recommended acceptance of letter from pumper. Flowmaster Inc. indicated “the septic system is functioning based on our limited knowledge”. Mr. Taylor stated that the septic will need to be pumped next year. Mr. Heino motioned to grant the variance for the exemption from Title V inspection requirement. Dr. Aronson seconded. Unanimous vote.

Hearing – Body Art Regulations – Addition of Apprentice License & Corrections

In attendance Jeff Ryan of Dharma Ink, Josh Genatassio and Dorian McCarron. After some discussion Mr. Taylor recommended approval. Mr. Heino motioned to accept the Apprenticeship position and the additional language and changes in the Body Art Regulations to regulate the Apprentice position. Dr. Aronson seconded. Unanimous vote.

Body Art Applications – Dorian McCarron – Piercing at Dharma Ink

-Waiver from Anatomy and Physiology Requirement

- Approval of Training Program in lieu of required experience

Mr. Taylor recommended approval of the waiver for the substitution of the college level anatomy course for the Anatomy and Physiology class required in the town regulations. Dr. Aronson motioned to grant the waiver and accept the college level anatomy Course as a substitution for the Anatomy and Physiology requirement as stated in the regulations. Mr. Heino seconded. Unanimous vote.

After some discussion Mr. Taylor recommended approval of the alternate training. Mr. Heino motioned to grant the approval of the training provided by the Fakir Musafar Intensive School of body piercing in lieu of required experience. Dr. Aronson seconded. Unanimous vote.

Discussion – Update Rubbish Removal

After some discussion Mr. Heino suggested that a letter be sent to let haulers know survey is coming. Send survey and invite haulers to hearing in December. Mr. Heino suggested getting input from Department of Public Works.

Discussion – Well Regulations

The Board requested to keep on the agenda for the next meeting.

Discussion – Nursing Contract

The Agents notified the Board that the nursing regulations have gone to legal for approval and signatures.

Agent's Report

Mr. Taylor informed the Board that My Brothers Keeper is having an event and they have a volunteer donating Port a Toilets at no cost. The company is not licensed in Easton. Mr. Taylor suggested that a temporary four day permit can be issued and the truck will need to be inspected. The Board agreed.

Mr. Taylor informed the Board that he is looking into Winterberry Hills project. He is checking with Department of Environmental Protection to verify regulations for concerns involving protection to the environment and the residents in the area.

Mr. Heino requested that a time be set to sign construction permits to make sure there is always someone available. Mr. Heino requested a change in the contact list for emergencies. Mr. Taylor should be first on list and then Mr. Heino.

Mr. Heino motioned to adjourn. Dr. Aronson seconded. Unanimous vote.
