Transportation Services

The Town of Easton, Council on Aging, provides local **curb-to-curb** transportation for essential services to destinations listed in the Weekly Shuttle Bus Schedule for Easton residents age 60 or over and for disabled residents of any age who have a temporary or permanent incapacity. Rides

for medical appointments are available Monday through Friday 8:30AM to 3:30PM. Rides are dependent on driver and van availability to destinations within the COA local service area.

Transportation is available for medical appointments in Boston on Wednesday and Friday mornings on a Brockton Area Transit Authority mini-bus and costs \$15 per round trip. Donations for COA shuttle van transportation are accepted and are needed to run the current schedule. The suggested COA donation is \$4 round trip for Easton destinations and \$6 round trip for destinations in surrounding towns. Discount shuttle punch cards are also available. With a punch card, a round trip ride in Easton costs approximately \$3.35 and a round trip in the COA service areas is approximately \$5. The cost of one pass is \$20 for rides scheduled during our regular business hours within our service area.

Requests for rides to destinations not listed on the Weekly Shuttle Bus Schedule are authorized if they fit into the schedule, or a second driver is available. The requested donation for destinations outside the local service area will be determined based on driver's time and the distance traveled. For rides to **medical appointments**, and to any other destinations not listed on the schedule, please call the COA office at **least 3 business days, but no more than 4 weeks**, in advance.

Please note that calling us with the proper notice does **not** guarantee a ride, as our capacity is limited to funding and the number of drivers and vans we have available. When our daily maximum is reached, we are not able to take additional ride requests.

For rides to destinations listed in the Weekly Shuttle Bus Schedule, please call the COA office **at least 2 business days** in advance. Ride cancellations should be made at least 24 hours in advance (not including weekends and holidays). Frequent cancellations may result in suspension of bus service. If the office is not open, please leave a message on our voice mail.
