

Stretch Energy Code Workshop

You are invited to attend an informative workshop on the “Stretch Code”, the optional appendix to the State Building Code. Adoption of the Stretch Energy Code is included as an article on Easton’s Warrant for Annual Town Meeting on May 17th, 2010.

The Stretch Code was developed in response to the call for improved building energy efficiency in Massachusetts. Towns and cities in the Commonwealth may adopt this in place of the energy efficiency requirements of the “base” building code. At this time 18 Massachusetts communities have chosen to do so.

Adoption of a code that minimizes the life cycle cost of new construction through energy efficiency, water conservation, and other renewable or alternative energy technologies is part of the criteria required of communities working to receive official Green Community designation and grant funds through the State’s Department of Energy Resources Green Communities Program.
