"Beauty & the Beast" Musical Theatre Class (ages 5-15)

Come join the fun and take part in a musical theatre performance. In this 8-week program children will learn the basics of putting together a production, including singing, dancing and acting. Boys and girls will audition for a role in a musical rewritten along the theme of the original "Beauty and the Beast". This program is held on Thursdays, October 6th – December 8th from 6:30-8:00PM at the Middle School auditorium (no classes 11/17 or 11/24). The last class and performance will take place Thursday December 8th from 6:30-8:00PM with the performance beginning at 7:15PM. Costumes are encouraged, but not necessary. The cost is \$125 per child. Please register by Thursday September 29th

Hip Hop Dance Class (ages 5-15)

Come learn the latest dance moves to the most popular music out right now. This class incorporates choreography and different forms of freestyle movement. At the end of the program children will hold a short performance for family and friends. This 8-week program takes place Tuesdays, September 27-November 15 from 6:30-7:30PM at Frothingham Hall, 15 Barrows Street. The cost is \$105 per child. Please register by Monday, September 26th.

Running Club (grades 3-8)

Join this popular 6-week program taking place after school at the Parkview field on Tuesdays and Thursdays September 27th – November 10th (no session 9/29) Participants in grades 3-5 will meet from 2:45-4:00PM and the cost is \$47 per child. A Recreation Department staff member will escort children in grades 3-5 to the field at dismissal. Participants in grades 6-8 will meet from 2:30-4:00PM and the cost is \$56 per child.
