SKI AND SNOWBOARD LESSONS (grades 3-8)

Easton Recreation, in conjunction with Blue Hills Ski Area, is offering ski and snowboard lessons. This 5-week program is held on Thursdays, January 12 - February 9 at Blue Hills in Canton, MA. Children will be picked up at school dismissal from Easton Middle and Olmsted/Richardson Schools and return to the Middle School at approximately 6:30PM. The cost is \$255 for lessons and mandatory helmet rental or \$330 for lessons and full equipment rental. **Additional paperwork is needed to register for this program. NEW YOGA (ages 7-14)

Looking for a place to unwind and just be yourself in a non-competitive environment? Come to the Easton Yoga Center to build strength and flexibility linking movement with your breath. Feel all of your everyday stress melt away, while having a blast! Children will learn basic yoga poses that will benefit them off and on the mat. This 6 week program is held on Wednesdays, November 30 – January 18 (no class December 14th or 28th) Girls ages 11-14 will meet from 3:15 – 4:15. Boys and girls ages 7-10 will meet from 4:30 – 5:30. The cost is \$65 per child. The Easton Yoga Center is located at 50 Oliver St. follow the signs. **The deadline to register is Tuesday November 22nd**

KARATE (grades K-5)

We are offering 4 weeks of karate instruction taught by Personal Best Karate. Students will learn basic karate skills such as kicks, strikes, and self defense techniques. This program will meet on Wednesdays, January 11-February 1. Grades 3-5 will meet from 3:30 – 4:15PM and grades K-2 will meet from 4:30 – 5:15PM at Frothingham Hall, 15 Barrows Street. The cost is \$30 per child. **The deadline to register is Wednesday January 4th**

Come join in on the fun of learning how to take part in a musical theater performance. Children will learn the basics of putting together a production. In this class, boys and girls will audition for a role in the musical “The Lion King.” This performance has been rewritten along the theme of the original “The Lion King”. Children will sing, dance and act their way into a world of excitement. This program is held on Thursdays, January 26-March 22, 2012 (no class February 23rd) from 6:30-8:00PM at the Middle School auditorium. The performance will take place on Thursday, March 22 at 7:15PM. Costumes are encouraged, but not necessary. The cost is \$125 per child. **The deadline to register is Wednesday January 18th**

HIP HOP DANCE CLASS (ages 5-13)

Come join in on the fun of learning the latest dance moves to the most popular music out right now! Students will learn various dances to popular songs. This class incorporates choreography and different forms of freestyle movement. At the end of the program children will hold a short performance for family and friends. This 8-week program takes place Tuesdays, January 24 – March 20, 2012 (no class February 21) from 6:30-7:30PM at Frothingham Hall, 15 Barrows Street. The cost is \$105 per child. **The deadline to register is Tuesday January 17th**.

HOMEWORK CLUB (grades 6-8)

Tired of trying to get homework done after dinner without additional resources? Join the Homework Club with teachers available each day to help you with any questions or problems you may have. This program takes place after school Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2:30-4:00PM at the Middle School library. This is a drop-in program. Students can attend as often or as little as they choose. There is no fee for this program thanks to generous donations. The late bus is available for students participating in this program. Boys & Girls Chess (grades 1-8)

This 6-week program meets on Tuesdays. Session 2 begins November 8th Session 3 begins December 20th. Children in grades 6-8 will meet in the EMS Cafeteria after school from 2:15 -3:15. Grades 3 – 5 will meet from 3:00 – 4:00 in the EMS cafeteria. A Recreation Department staff member will escort children in grades 3-5 to the Middle School cafeteria at school dismissal. Grades 1-3 (grade 3 can choose either time) will meet from 4:00-5:00PM in the EMS library. Sessions are on-going throughout the school year and separate flyers are distributed for this program. The cost is \$40 per child.
