**EASTON SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEETING
WORKSHOP MINUTES
Thursday, February 25, 2010**

Minutes of the School Committee Workshop Meeting of February 25, 2010, convened at 4:05 p.m. in the Conference Room at 50 Oliver Street. Present were: Caroline O'Neill, Jane Martin, William Braun, Rebecca Turley, Nancy DeLuca, Wes Paul, John Giuggio, and Mike Green.

Mr. Paul presented a proposed Oliver Ames High School Master Schedule. He explained that the reason for the proposal came out of a 2004 NEAS&C Accreditation Recommendation Report. Mr. Paul shared with the Committee the steps that had been taken to date which led to the proposed master schedule. He also shared the benefits and costs associated with the implementation of this proposed schedule.

Mrs. Less arrived at 4:50 p.m. and then left at 5:30 p.m. due to illness in her family.

Mr. Giuggio presented a proposed Easton Middle School Schedule. He explained that the schedule, if implemented, would create a uniform schedule for all students and teachers in grades 6 – 8. Mr. Giuggio explained that the schedule would enhance course offerings. Costs associated with the implementation of this proposed schedule were shared and discussed.

The Superintendent mentioned that the cafeteria workers had voted to ratify the three-year tentative agreement that had been negotiated with the School Committee. This three-year contract covers the 2009 – 2012 time period.

After a review of the terms included in the agreement, on a motion by Vice Chair Martin, seconded by Mrs. Turley, the successor agreement with the cafeteria workers was unanimously ratified.

On a motion by Vice Chair Martin, seconded by Dr. Braun, and with the members polled, the Committee entered into Executive Session at 5:45 p.m. for the initial review of Assistant Superintendent candidates.
