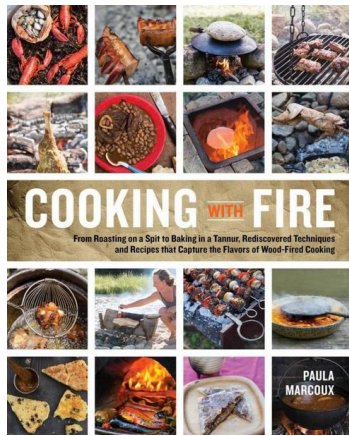


Cooking with Fire
