Dear Property Owner;

The Town of Easton is currently considering the design, permitting, and construction of sewer infrastructure in the general area of Washing Street/Route 138 between Belmont and Depot Streets. This area, the Queset Commercial District, is contained within the Easton Center needs area as defined by our Comprehensive Wastewater Management Plan. This plan would see the Town construct sewer infrastructure within the public ways for the purpose of collecting wastewater to be treated at the future Queset Commons Wastewater Treatment Plant.

As part of this process, the Board of Selectmen, as Sewer Commissioners of Easton, have voted a preliminary Queset Sewer District for the purposes of identifying parcels to have access to future sewer capacity. You are receiving this letter because your property is either in, or abuts this area.

For your benefit we have posted the Queset Commercial District Recommended Map and Concept Feasibility Study and Report, prepared by Woodard and Curran, as well as other related information on our website. Please visit www.easton.ma.us/sewer to access this information. This current Queset Sewer District is in the early stages of planning and the Town of Easton hopes to get input from you and other property owners prior to spring Town Meeting. To see to this, the Town will be hosting a public information session to receive public input and answer questions. The meeting details are below.
