524 Depot Street Master Plan Development Team

Mission: Develop a vision for future use of the property at 524 Depot Street purchased by the town for permanently open space, potential active recreational use and potential future municipal facilities.

Membership: Nine (9) persons to be appointed by the Board of Selectmen consisting of at least 5 town residents to include: one (1) Board of Selectmen member, Planning Department designee, the Recreation Director; (1) representative from the Recreational Commission, one (1) representative of the Conservation Commission, (1) representative from the Community Preservation Committee; (1) representative from the Municipal Building Committee and no less than two (2) residents at-large.

The Team shall be appointed for a period of no more than six (6) months; however, that period may be extended for a specified period of time at the Board of Selectmen's discretion.

Tasks: The Team shall:

1. Become familiar with the site, documenting physical and geographical constraints, as well as important natural resources. This may involve seeking funding and authorization to conduct certain assessments and analysis such as wetlands delineation and wildlife and natural community assessments;
2. Determine and develop plans showing suitable locations for such purposes as wildlife habitat protection; walking trails and nature observation; active outdoor recreational uses;
3. Present draft plan to the Board of Selectmen and the represented boards;
4. Conduct public informational and comment session.
