TOWN OF EASTON SEWER SYSTEM TECHNICAL ADVISORY BOARD CHARGE

Mission:

To review plans to develop, expand or rehabilitate sewer collection and treatment systems in the Town of Easton. To advise, as needed, the Sewer Commissioners and Selectmen on technical considerations during the planning, design and construction of sewers and wastewater treatment facilities.

Membership:

Five (5) persons to be appointed by the Board of Selectmen consisting of at least three members with direct experience in civil or environmental engineering, urban planning, utility construction or management, or real estate development. The Director of Public Works/Town Engineer shall be a member and serve as Clerk of the Board and be responsible for the maintaining of minutes, agendas, and documents pertaining to the Council.

All appointees shall serve for a term of three years. Residency in the Town is preferred, but not required.

Tasks:

The Advisory Board will meet as needed shall report to the Board of Sewer Commissioners at least once annually or as requested by the Board. The Board's responsibilities will include:

- 1. The Board will review all proposed sanitary sewer and waste water treatment facility plans.
- 2. The Board will provide the Board of Selectmen with recommendations for potential changes, revisions, or additions to the sanitary sewer infrastructure in Town.
- 3. The Board shall seek input from any Town board or agency relative to such plans as is necessary.
