REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Application & Clearance from the Conservation Department
- 2. Application & Clearance from the Board of Health
- 3. 10' from septic system & house-ABOVE GROUND POOLS
- 4. 20' from septic system & 10' from house-IN-GROUND POOLS
- 5. 15' from side lot line (Residential Zone) 25' from side lot line (Business Zone)
- 6. 20' from rear lot line (Residential Zone) 40' from rear lot line (Business Zone)
- 7. 25' from any street (Residential Zone) 75' from any street (Business Zone)
- 8. Plan of fencing detail design required with application Please Note: Fencing should be a minimum height of 4' above finish grade with a self-closing, self- latching gate. The gate latch must be 54' above finish grade.

INSPECTIONS:

Building: Inground or above ground pools.

- 1. Building inspector to be called before pool is back-filled or to check gunite pool before cement is applied.
- 2. Final inspection is done when pool is completed and fence is installed with proper gates.

Electrical: Inground or above ground pools.

- 1. Wiring inspector to be called before pool is back-filled and grounding /conduits are checked.
- 2. Call for final wiring inspection upon completion of pool.

Gas: Inground pools.

1. Gas inspector to be called for underground piping and when gas piping is complete.
