



## **Phase II of the Five Corners Sewer Construction Project is Complete**

The Town of Easton is pleased to announce the completion of phase II of the **Five Corners Sewer Construction Project**. Ensuring the reliability of the Town's infrastructure systems is critical for the continued growth and vitality of Easton's neighborhoods and community. The Five Corners Sewer is designed to provide 165,000 gallons of daily treatment capacity to the district and follows more than five years of planning, outline and voter approvals at town meetings.

The Easton Department of Public Works would like to express appreciation to the public for their patience shown throughout this project, and thank all of the municipal staff and contractors for their efforts to complete this necessary sewer work.

### **The project includes the installation of:**

- A sanitary sewer collection system with approximately 2,700 linear feet of 6-inch sewer force main.
- 11,100 linear feet of gravity sewer.
- 850 linear feet of low-pressure sewer.
- 6,000 linear feet of water main replacement for the Mulberry Brook and Beaver Brook Stream Crossings.
- Construction of the Foundry Street Pump Station.

***Miscellaneous follow-up activities and punch list work may be ongoing at times in the upcoming weeks, but major impacts and consistent presence of the contractor in the project area has concluded.***

**Notice to property owners:** Property owners in the Five Corners Sewer District that would like to connect should contact a Licensed Drain Layer or contact a contractor who is eligible to become licensed to begin the process of connecting to sewer. The cost to connect to the sewer lines installed by the Town is the responsibility of the property owner. The Easton Department of Public Works would like to recommend getting as many quotes as possible for

the work and to be clear on what is or is not included in the scope of work (i.e. restoration of lawns, driveways, walkways, removal of trees, internal plumbing changes, abandonment of septic or cesspool, pumping of the old system, cost of permits, etc.).

Only Licensed Drain Layers (or those applying to be licensed) may apply for a sewer permit. The Town of Easton will license contractors that have experience installing municipal sanitary sewer laterals, that possess the insurance required and applicable performance bond. Please note that those properties that need to connect via a low pressure pump should contact a professional engineer to design and stamp the low pressure system.

Permits and the associated application fees must be submitted to the respective Departments for approval. Each of these permits is available for download from the [Public Works Permit webpage](#).
