



Scheduled Construction Activities for the Week of February 10, 2020

During the week of February 10, 2020, C. Naughton Corp is tentatively scheduled to perform the following construction activities:

- The pipe crew will complete gravity sewer services on Poquanticut Avenue on Monday and will then begin gravity sewer main installation from Poquanticut Avenue into South Street.
- **Traffic Notice:** As the pipe crew proceeds to work on Poquanticut Avenue to the north of South Street, southbound through-traffic on Poquanticut Avenue will be detoured onto Beaver Dam Road to the east, then south onto Bay Road, and back to the Five Corners intersection. All residents of Poquanticut Avenue south of Beaver Dam Road and north of South Street will have continuous access from the north. This includes all residents on Roundtable Road, Excaliber Lane, and Armor Lane. **Emergency vehicles and school buses will have access as necessary, and normal bus routes will be maintained.** Residents of Poquanticut Avenue to the south of South Street will have continuous access from Foundry Street or South Street.
 - ***The detour will remain in effect until the crew has completed this portion of work and has removed all equipment from the intersection of Poquanticut Avenue and South Street.***
- The testing of manhole structures and previously installed mains will be ongoing on Foundry Street between the hours of 9:00AM and 3:00PM. This work involves service trucks and small crews set up in isolated areas in the eastbound lane on Foundry Street. Traffic in both directions will be maintained by an alternating pattern around work zones using the westbound lane on Foundry Street. Brief and intermittent delays should be expected in both directions on Foundry Street.
- Construction operations will continue at the pump station site located at 564 Foundry Street throughout the week.

The contractor will continue working throughout the winter months on the pump station installation and depending on weather conditions may perform some limited excavation within the roadway on side streets. The remaining roadway work (Bay Road, Depot Street, Foundry Street east of Five Corners)

will resume in the spring.
