



Scheduled Construction Activities for the Week of September 2, 2019

During the week of September 2, 2019, C. Naughton Corp is tentatively scheduled to perform the following construction activities:

- Construction crews will continue to perform stream crossing operations to facilitate the installation of water main, sewer piping, as well as the installation of associated structures in the south shoulder of the roadway on Foundry Street in the New Pond area.
- Secondary crew(s) will work to complete water main installation.
- **There will be no work on site on Monday, September 2, 2019 in observance of the Labor Day Holiday.**
- Crews will also focus on general site housekeeping and maintenance.



Temporary Water Main Bypass

As part of the Five Corner's Sewer Construction Project; the Town's contractor will begin to install temporary water main bypass. This work involves the following tasks, which may cause a temporary disturbance to you:

- Temporary bypass piping and hose could be installed along the side of the roadway. Watch your step when walking around any exposed infrastructure and avoid damage to your vehicle by driving cautiously near the temporary piping.

- The installation of the water main bypass may require that the water to your property be temporarily interrupted. We will work diligently to mitigate all service disruptions.
- Property access may be required to provide temporary water service to your property.
- Due to the increased water pressure in the water main, you may experience air in your interior plumbing or discolored/cloudy water. We recommend that you run your cold water until the air passes and the water becomes clear.

The Foundry Street detour is operational and will remain in place 24 hours a day, 7 days per week until the winter months when it will be deactivated. It may be necessary to reactivate the detour in the spring of 2020 for roadway restoration activities. Traffic monitoring will continue throughout the project, and adjustments will be made as necessary.

Construction activities will be performed Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Please plan ahead for travel and expect delays. The Town of Easton appreciates your patience during this construction project and reminds everyone to please drive safely.
